

In April 2024 SAI Brazil in collaboration with the Auditoría Superior de la Federación in Mexico City, held a one-week training in Mexico City to train Organization of Latin American and Caribbean Supreme Audit Institutions (OLACEFs) auditors on the "Climate Scanner Rapid Review Framework."

The "Climate Scanner Rapid Review Framework" is a tool used to evaluate government actions related to climate change. The project focuses on three axes: Governance, Public Policies, and Climate Finance.

The Climate Scanner is an initiative of the Chairman of the <u>International Organization of Supreme Audit Institutions (INTOSAI)</u> (SAI Brazil/Federal Court of Accounts (TCU)) and based on the partnership with The Working Group on Environmental Auditing (<u>WGEA</u>).

The training's main objective was to provide SAI auditors with the necessary knowledge to effectively apply the Climate Scanner rapid review framework and carry out this project smoothly across all participating SAIs.

The project developed a methodology that allows the audit institutions to make a rapid assessment of the implementation phase of climate change programs.

The Office of the Auditor General of Belize completed the assessment based on the "Climate Scanner Rapid Review Framework" in 2024 with engagement from stakeholders.

The results of the assessment for all countries have not yet been finalized and are not publicly available. A link to the Belize assessment will be shared as soon as it becomes available.
